WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR/MAINTENANCE MAN/SANITATION WORKER

This employee will work directly under the supervision of the Director of Operations and will be able to work efficiently unsupervised.

Location : Key First Nation

Duties:

- Perform daily inspections and carry out associated operational checks of all water and wastewater equipment to ensure all are operating efficiently and in compliance to the applicable regulations
- Ensure proper operation of water and sewage processes, pumps and chemical feeders
- Perform preventative maintenance and repairs to water and waste water equipment and all community buildings
- Ensure garbage is removed from KFN homes, band office, health clinic, community hall and daycare and transported to the dump weekly
- Ensure the garbage bins are maintained
- Provide maintenance duties for all KFN band needs as identified by the housing department or Director of Operations, this includes house maintenance work

Qualifications:

- Must have a Water Treatment Plant operators certificate
- Must have a valid driver's license and a registered truck
- Must be able to demonstrate effective time management skills
- Must be willing to work after hours from time to time
- Must be able to maintain operational and maintenance records to comply with INAC
- Must have good communication skills as this person will be working with the public, band employees, and funders
